The Stats NZ Jacoby Prize is awarded by the Population Association of New Zealand for the best **paper on a New Zealand-related population topic written during a course of university study.**

The competition is open to all current or immediate past tertiary students throughout New Zealand. All entrants will receive free registration to the 2019 New Zealand Population Conference upon acceptance of their submitted paper.

The 2019 Jacoby Prize will be awarded during the Conference to be held 20-21 June 2019 at Te Papa, Wellington.

The winner will receive:

- \$500 from Stats NZ
- conference travel, accommodation and registration courtesy of PANZ
- two year's free membership to the Association
- publication of the winning essay in the New Zealand Population Review
