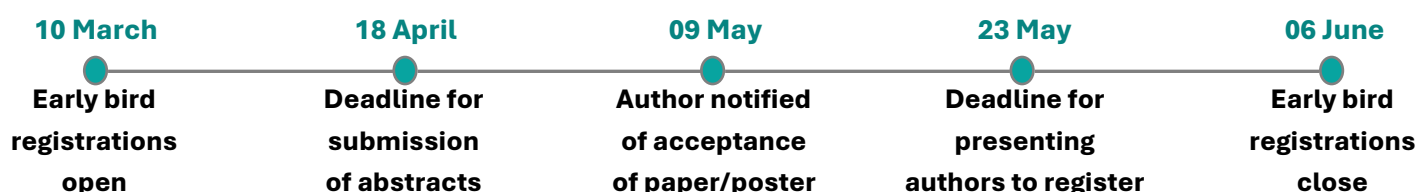

Guidelines for submissions

PAPERS

- This is an in-person conference and all presenting authors are required to register for and attend the conference.
- Authors interested in presenting a paper need to submit a 200–250 word abstract along with a working title, full names, affiliations and email addresses of all co-authors; and indicating the name(s) of the presenting author(s).
- Abstracts should include the conference themes that are most relevant to the paper.

POSTERS

- Authors interested in presenting a poster need to submit a 200–300 word abstract along with a working title, full names, affiliations and email addresses of all co-authors.
- Abstracts should include the conference themes that are most relevant to the poster.
- At least one author of accepted posters is expected to register and be present to discuss their poster content during the poster session scheduled.
- If accepted, an electronic version of the poster must be submitted in A0 poster format via email to nzpopcon@population.org.nz by the deadline.
- Accepted posters should be printed in A0 format (approx. 1200 x 800mm) on a single sheet of card and brought to the registration desk on 10 July 2024 morning.
- All accepted posters (including entries from those who are not students) will be eligible for the people's choice award (\$250 cash prize) for the most popular poster as voted by conference delegates.
